

Raising of the 5th (Home Service) Battalion Yorkshire Regiment.

- Headquarters.** 1. The Battalion will be assembled in the first instance at Scarborough where all recruits will be sent, and directed to report themselves at The Orderly Room, Grand Hotel.
- Recruiting Area.** 2. The recruiting area will be the Malton, Pickering Lythe, Bulmer East and West, Ryedale and Whitby Strand Petty Sessional Divisions of the North Riding, the Borough of Scarborough, and the whole of the East Riding outside the County Borough of Hull.
- National Reservists.** 3. It is open for recruiting to National Reservists who fulfil the following conditions :—
- (a) Members of Class II. **registered in that Class prior to August 11th, 1914.**
 - (b) Members of Class II. registered in that Class on or after August 11th, 1914, provided that they are 35 years of age or less.
 - (c) Members of Class III. Section A, provided they are 35 years of age or less.
- Recruits.** 4. Other Recruits will be attested for four years under the usual Territorial Force conditions, but free discharges will be given to all who require them at the conclusion of the war.
5. Although no guarantee can be given, ex-Non-Commissioned Officers will, if possible, be promoted to their former rank in the new unit, and if this cannot be done immediately on enlistment, their claims will receive consideration as vacancies occur.
- Service.** 6. The Battalion will be utilised for service at home only, but individuals will be permitted and encouraged to volunteer for service abroad, more particularly in the County Territorial Battalions.
- Engagements.** 7. The terms of engagement will be as follows :—
- (a) For Members of the National Reserve—one year with the colours, or, if the embodiment of the Territorial Force lasts longer than one year, then until that Force is disembodied. If, however, the Force is disembodied before the expiration of one year, they may be discharged at once. (Use A. F.'s E. 514 and 514 A, for attestation.)
 - (b) For all other recruits—four years with the colours, but should the war be over in a shorter period, applications for free discharge will be favourably considered by the County Association. (Use A. F.'s E, 501 and 501 A, for attestation.)
- Age for Enlistment.** 8. The ages for enlistment are as follows :—
- (a) For National Reservists, Registered in Class II.—ex-Sergeants and above, up to 55. Ex-other Ranks, up to 50. (See para. 3 A.)
 - (b) For all others—17 to 35 years, as laid down in Territorial Force Regulations.
- Final Approval.** 9. All recruits attested will be sent to Scarborough for final approval by the Officer Commanding, Lt.-Colonel R. Chichester Constable, and if rejected, will be sent back to their homes free of all charge.
10. Owing to the present very great difficulty in obtaining uniforms and other kit, recruits should if possible bring with them a serviceable overcoat and boots, and as much underclothing as possible.

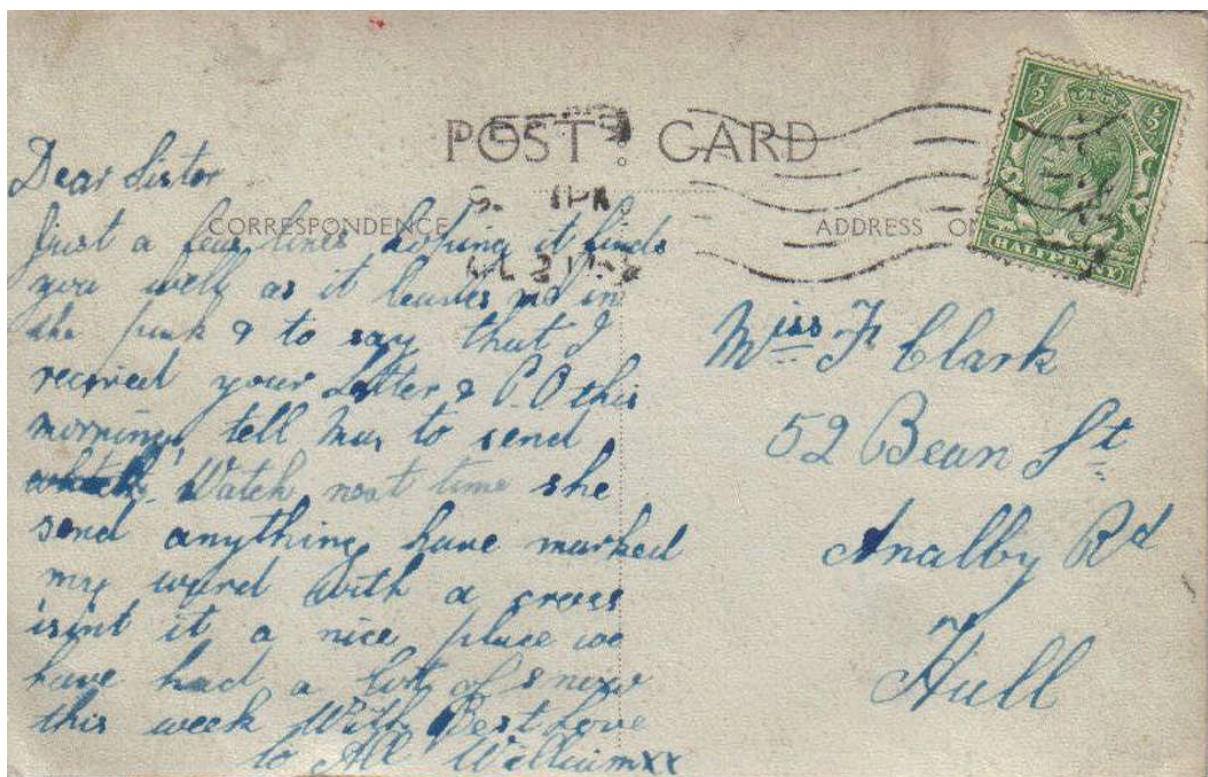

From 2nd Northern Military Hospital front - Postmarked 2nd April 1917



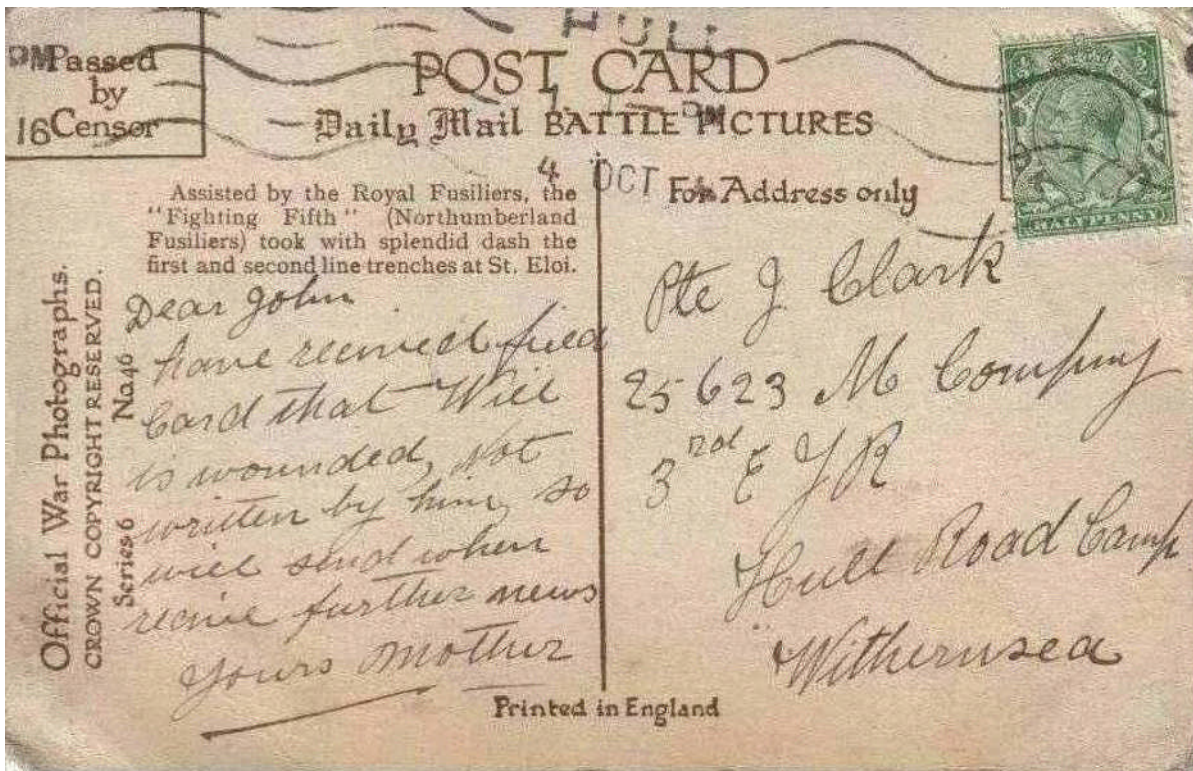
From 2nd Northern Military Hospital reverse - Postmarked 2nd April 1917



Will is wounded , front - Postmarked 4th October 1916



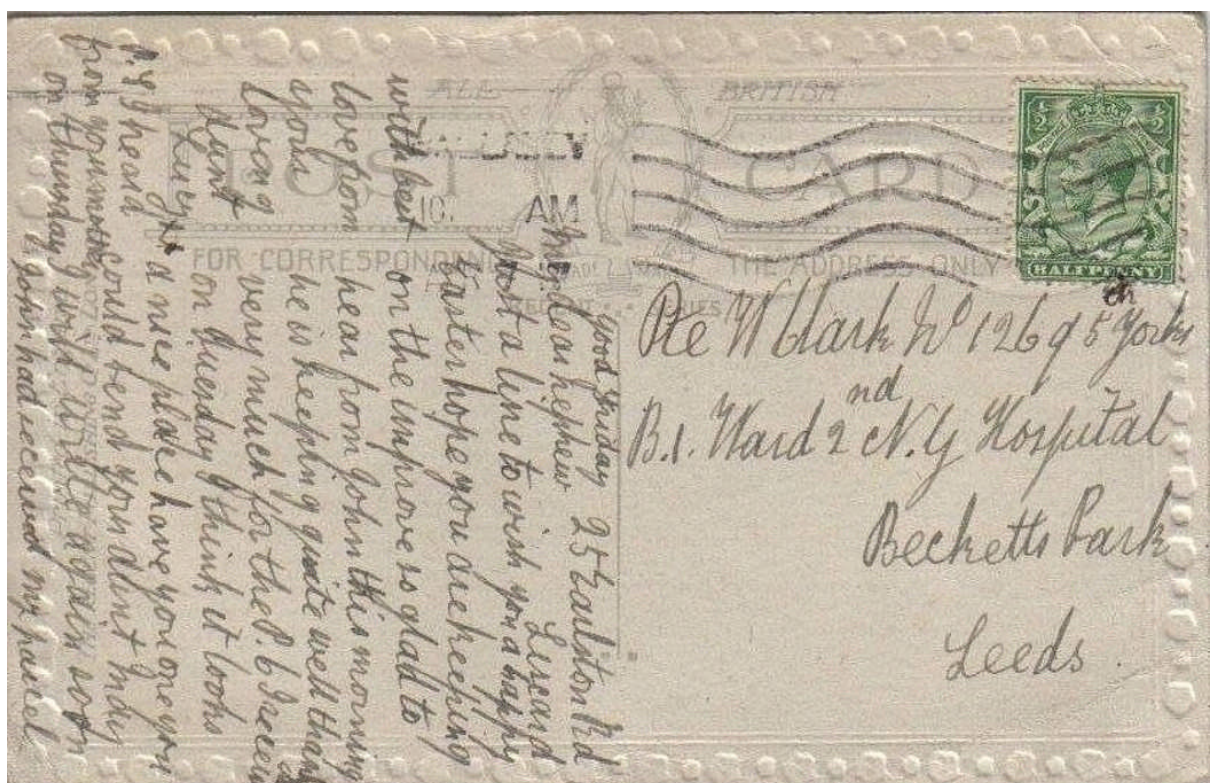
Will is wounded, reverse - Postmarked 4th October 1916
